

## DIRECTOR'S NOTES by Roger Castellano



## The WIZARD of OZ... then...now...and always...

A brain, a heart, a home, the nerve. As you recall the iconic desires that are embodied in a remarkable story, one cannot appreciate this endearing tale without acknowledging the history of the story and the man who was responsible for keeping us young at heart.

At the time when L. Frank Baum's beloved fairy tale was published, he was a struggling 44-year-old actor, playwright, storekeeper, newspaper editor, traveling salesman, and magazine publisher...in addition to writing several unsuccessful children's books. But very shortly after, Oz was an instantaneous hit, leading to a wildly successful 1903 Broadway musical (with music and songs unfamiliar to us now) and toured for over a decade.

This success made a huge industry for Baum, who wrote librettos, lyrics, film scenarios and 13 addition *Oz* books which told of further adventures of Dorothy and her friends. There were also *Oz* Toys, dolls and games; silent films in the year 1908, 1910, 1914 and 1925; a cartoon short in 1933; and a radio show in 1933-1934.

But it wasn't until the purchasing of *Oz* by Metro-Goldwyn-Mayer Studios did the story make its most lasting impression. A perfect film to highlight 16-year-old Judy Garland.

But the trip down the Yellow Brick Road wasn't always a pleasant one. There were troubles with the screenplay, five different directors, and challenges in casting. (Gale Sondergaard was to be a glamorous Wicked Witch until the idea was scrapped; Buddy Ebsen was to be the Tin Man, but aluminum paint got into his lungs and hospitalized him for months and 124 little people had to be located to populate Munchkinland).

Actual filming took a full year. The song, "The Jitterbug" was cut from the finished film, and a similar fate almost met "Over the Rainbow," which was in and out of the picture at different previews.

But luckily, a happy ending was waiting at the end of the rainbow. A perfect, classic film resulted, delighting movie audiences all over the world, and garnering rave reviews and Academy Award nominations (losing Best Picture to *Gone with the Wind*, but winning Oscars for score and song, with a special statuette for Judy Garland). Television rights were purchased in 1956, and the film enjoyed an unprecedented number of annual national telecasts.

Tonight's performance includes several delightful lyrics written for (but edited out of) the final film, as well as the cut "Jitterbug" number.

The Wizard of Oz is the greatest musical ever written about looking for your heart's desire. I hope you find what you are looking for as you join us tonight as we travel down our Yellow Brick Road.




